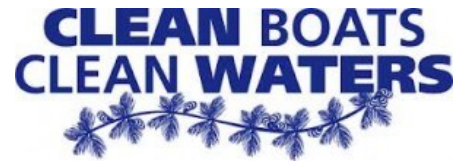




**Clean Boats Clean Waters**  
**Monroe County Train-the-Trainers Workshop**

This training session will be a hands-on learning experience for those concerned with preventing and/or teaching others how to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species. This training will consist of a three hour classroom segment followed by a three hour field segment where participants will participate in a boat wash.

Classroom topics include:

- What is the Clean Boats, Clean Waters program and why is it important?
- How can we organize aquatic invasive species programs in our area?
- How can we share what we learn with others?

In Field topics include:

- Hands on inspection and disinfection techniques
- Recording activity results
- Informing boaters of appropriate techniques for inspecting and cleaning their boating equipment and compliance with Michigan law

Classroom activities will take place in the Knabusch Math & Science Center and the afternoon field segment at the Bolles Harbor Public Boat launch. All training materials will be provided as well as on-site lunch and refreshments.

This program is being facilitated by the Western Lake Erie Cluster and the Monroe Conservation District with funding provided by the Monroe County Environmental Fund.
