Commercial agriculture pesticide containers HDPE plastics with resin code #2 & #7. All size Jugs (caps removed), Plastic Drums (caps removed), Plastic Shuttles (cap cut off top, cut down into sheets, cages not accepted).

All containers must be power washed/triple rinsed and punctured. Absolutely no residue can be remaining on the interior or exterior of the container. All labels and booklets must be removed.
